

### **Snack Money Update**

All snack money is now being collected electronically via ipay. Staff are no longer allowed to accept cash in the ELC. Our School Office staff are very happy to help you set up ipay if you are having any difficulties.

The £1.50 paid will be used solely for snack and no money will now be added to our nursery fund from this, previously 55p went towards snack and 55p went towards the nursery fund.



# FELC Time & Pick Up routine changes.

We have looked carefully at how the end of our afternoon sessions were running in the ELC and having listened to parental feedback and staff team discussions. As a result, we have made some changes. Those of you who pick up later on in the afternoon, (after 3:30pm) will have noticed that our children are enjoying their snack together in the extension area of our hall before returning to play. The children are enjoying this social activity and are also enjoying having the opportunity to mix with our P1-3 Primary School pupils who attend wraparound. (This is particularly good experience

for our children who will attend school next year as it will help them with that transition already!)

On your arrival at ELC, if you could allow a staff team member to bring your child through to you from snack, this would help to alleviate congestion in what is a very narrow corridor.

If you are not here once your child has finished his/her snack, they will return to the ELC to play until you collect them.

Again, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you that all children should have left the build-

ing by 3:57pm.

If you have any questions about this change to the routine, please do not hesitate to speak to a member of the ELC staff.

\*\* You will also have noticed that we have made other changes to our routines so you are no longer picking up from "free flow play" as you told us this was quite difficult. We now have a selection of focused learning opportunities at the end of each session which children choose to take part in and you will find your children here. Please let us know how you feel this is working, we really appreciate your feedback.
