This year our Primary 7 pupils are taking part in an extended transition project based on developing skills for learning. life and work. The context for this project is Broxburn in the Past, Present and Future and the purpose is to develop a sense of pride in and knowledge about our community, which is steeped in history and played a leading role in the industrial revolution. The Primary 7 pupils will learn about this through many curricular areas and will have an opportunity to spend more time at the Academy with other Primary 7 pupils from within the Cluster.

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What We Are Learning?

At Broxburn Primary School we learn many things, but some parents and carers might not know, so let's find out!

Our Primary I children will be learning about planting and their bodies this term. They will also be spending time introducing the children from our Early Learning Centre to the routines of life in Primary I, as part of our extended transition processes.



In Primary 2 the children will be learning all about their Senses. They will be conducting experiments related to this and writing poems about their Senses too.



Primary 3 are excited to be learning about the similarities and differences between canals and rivers in their learning context Broxburn Waterways.

This term Primary 4 are learning about William Wallace And Robert The Bruce, including their role in the Wars of Scottish Independence and what life was like during this time.

Primary 5 will be learning about life in the Victorian times by creating a museum for other classes to visit. Please note that the P5a Assembly will now be held on Friday 21st June. This date has changed and we apologise for any inconvenience caused due to unforeseen circumstances.

Primary 6 are learning about the Scottish Parliament. They will be examining key features of a democracy and develop their understanding of the roles and responsibilities of citizens within society. This will be linked to applications for House Captains and Leadership roles next year in Primary 7.



Primary 7 will be learning all about Broxburn in the past, present and future throughout their transition project with Bathgate Academy. They will also be heading off to Kingswood camp in Hexham this week. We hope they have a great time and that the sun shines for them.
