KEY WORKER INFORMATION

Lots of our families have been allocated a Key Worker place for their child and we now have over 100 pupils registered for Key Worker places within our school and ELC.

In order to help us ensure this support is as safe as possible for everyone please can we politely remind key workers of the following information:

- Each week Key Worker families will be emailed a form to complete to share with us the days you do/do not need the service. This information enables us to provide staffing for the children within the school and we appreciate you completing this.
- Children should only attend on days when you have no childcare alternatives.
- If you are working from home or at home caring for other children then your child/children should be with you at home.
