INSPIRE

- Celebrate success with the Youth Achievement Award Programme
- Building Resilience in Numeracy Group led by Mr Page
- Buy additional devices to engage children in learning using the Participatory Budget, which is decided through consultation with children and families.



ACHIEVE

- Carry out teacher led Practitioner Enquiry to engage in small tests of change, to improve writing
- Continue to staff our Small Group Setting to provide emotional support and learning for some children



CARE

- Improve Attendance through monitoring and support meetings
- Provide daily Purposeful Play for some children
- Emotional support for some through Superhero Sidekicks
- Work alongside partners to provide opportunities for new experiences for children, including Family Unity Nurture, Planet Soccer, camp, trips and clubs
- Provide support for parents and carers through our Broxburn Blether Sessions
