Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back I hope you all had a relaxing February break.

We are delighted to share that last month a team of visitors made up of Education Officers, Head Teachers and members of the Central Equity Team spent a week with us here in school in order to review the evaluations of the school and ELC in learning, teaching, assessment, attainment, achievement and personalised support. They observed learning, spent time in our ELC spaces and spoke to children and staff.

The team highlighted the excellent environments we offer, our engaging learning, our value of care, our inclusive approaches and creative curriculum and were able to validate that we are very good in all of these areas. Our children did us so proud and were able to share the considerable experiences they have to lead learning and contribute to school life. The team were really impressed with their knowledge about equity and how to support reducing the cost of the school day for all.

Working alongside the team we were also able to identify areas for improvement. These include learning profiles, further development of our curriculum and learner voice, and the creation of an equity strategy. These areas will form the basis of our school improvement plan next session.

Huge thanks to the children, staff and families for their engagement with the review. Giving us a fantastic opportunity to reflect on the wonderful experiences learners have here at Broxburn Primary School and ELC.


## Scottish Poetry Recital
